
**Death of Eagan Oscar Earl Von
Trotha.**

Mr. Von Trotha died October 8 at his home seven miles west of Greeley of tonsilitis, after a sickness of about five weeks, aged 23 years and eleven months.

He was the young man who went to the Klondike and came home through Montana, carrying upon his person quite a sum of money, which he one day gave to his traveling companion to place in the bank, but the latter proved unfaithful and absconded with all the money, leaving his friend in destitute circumstances.

Young Von Trotha was unmarried. He leaves two sisters, Lottie and Esther, and five brothers, Bodo, Erich, Otto, Lothar and Claude. The body was shipped to Denver for burial, the father and one brother having been interred there some years ago.
