

Von Trotha Returns With Lambs To Feed Here During Winter

B. L. Von Trotha, Weld rancher and stock feeder, returned Tuesday evening from Salt Lake City where he took delivery on about 4,000 lambs which he bought on contract last spring. Von Trotha Brothers will feed about 5,000 lambs and about 400 cattle this spring. Most of the 12 or 13 carloads of lambs on which B. L. Von Trotha took delivery while in Salt Lake City have already arrived at their feed lots in Weld county.

Feeders are coming into this section from all of the range country at this time, the present run being mostly from Wyoming, Utah and Nevada. There are also some coming from Montana, Idaho and eastern Oregon.
